Subject: Update on sculpture re-installations

Hello Diane,

I'm assuming you are still the temporary city contact on the repair projects of the City's sculpture collection. The snow should be gone soon and the last few sculptures can be installed. Last year, I did not bill for the installation of the pieces below due to the Christmas blizzard and continuous snow falls and giant snow piles. This winter was rough.

Emily at the Zoo asked us to wait to install *Sitting Cheetah* because they are doing construction in that area at present. That is also the piece that could use a quartzite stone slightly raised above grade to keep the sculpture out of the decorative bark and dirt. We can start planning for that if that is still a go.

Also, she said, the *Snow Monkeys* need to wait for installation because their fountain is covered with snow piles. The zoo staff was running out of places to put the snow over the winter so they piled it toward the fountain since the sculptures weren't there.

Our World for City Hall is best to wait until all the snow has melted away and a few rains have washed the salt away. The sculpture is repainted and recoated but since it is primarily steel, the less exposure to salts the better! It would be so beneficial to move that piece indoors if at all possible. Hint. I know RLA would highly recommend that as well. If you know of a space...

As you may know from Kellen, the restored *In Varietate Concordia* cranes are in the Orpheum courtyard waiting. We would like to reconnect them very soon but would recommend grinding off the surface rust on the stainless steel "straps" they had been welded to. That wasn't something we had in the original estimate but it won't be much extra time. Let us know how to proceed on that and we can work on that ASAP before people are out in the courtyard.

I will put together an estimate for the above remaining installation costs- essentially what we had omitted from last year's invoices. We can resubmit the estimates on the paint touch up on the *Hungry Bears* and patina work on *Hey, Mary Lou* to be ready to go on those when the warm weather eventually gets here. I know you have a few recent quote requests, as well.



Hi Lisa,

Thanks for your update Monday. Yes, I'm still the temporary liaison for the Arts.

I've attached the spreadsheets for our R&M Log for city owned artwork. Looks like you gave us some pricing for reinstalling sculpture that we carried over for our 2023 budget. Please review and let me know if this is still accurate or needs updating. The log also lists additional R&M work that RLA provided in their 2022 Report based on short-term, mid-term and long-term pieces, based on priority. If any of these are sculpture that you're able to review for updates, please provide pricing at your convenience. I've also cc'd Matt Newman so he's able to review and approve with PO's for those under \$2,500 or provide an RFP for those over that amount. Please provide pricing for grinding the surface rust from the SS straps for the Cranes for reinstallation. Kellen also mentioned at yesterday's meeting that you may need to know placement of the Cranes based on their color which has some significance. On review of photos, here's the placement of the cranes in my Word diagram (north is to the right).



I was able to review your information at yesterday's VAC meeting and the board will consider indoor placement for the *Our World* sculpture. On review of RLA's report it indicates that the sculpture should be "elevated to help with the recurrence of corrosion as it is subjected to less sprinkler overspray, de-icing salts/brine, and snow build-up. "I think we have an inexpensive option for quartzite pedestals if you think elevating as RLA suggest would minimize corrosion? Do you think 24"-36" would be adequate, if this is an option?

Thank you for your communication with Zoo Staff for re-installing sculpture out there. Hopefully, we're coming to the end of our snow season and you guys can regain space back from housing sculptures over the winter.
