## PACKAGE LIQUOR -- NEW

<b>EXPLANATION</b>	An applicant wishing to sell package liquor (spirits, wine, and beer)
	must obtain a Package Liquor License.
FEE	<u>\$533</u> which includes publication and fire inspection fees.
SCHEDULING	From the time of receipt of application until City Council action is approximately four to six weeks.
HOURS TO SELL	7 a.m. to 2 a.m., Monday through Sunday.
TERM	The Package Liquor License runs from January 1 through December 31 of any given year and renewed in the Fall.
RESTRICTIONS	Alcohol must be purchased to be consumed off premise. No alcohol can be consumed on site.
	The number of Package Liquor Licenses is restricted by population per State Law.
	• If business derives 50% or more of their gross business from alcoholic beverages, the minimum age to sell alcoholic beverages is 21. If business derives less than 50% of their gross business from alcoholic beverages, the minimum age to sell is 18 with no requirement for have an employee age 21 or older on duty.
	No person under the age of 18 is permitted to sell any type of alcoholic beverage in any establishment.
CHECKLIST	The first step for the applicant will be to complete page 1 of the Alcohol License Application Checklist and send both pages to the Licensing Specialist (contact information below).
