2. Approval of Minutes of March 6, 2024, Meeting

5. Community Housing Updates

- Bill O'Connor gave an update on the uptick in interest rates. The 2 year and 10 year have creeped up again. Additionally, there is less optimism on the amount of rate cuts the industry is expecting this year.
- Dawn Marie Johnson gave an update from the school board perspective. They passed a budget with teach pay increased on track with their goals.
- Jeff Nelson gave a quick update on the housing market. While rates remain high, the market is starting to pick up. Kenley shared the RASE monthly housing stats.
- Councilor Selberg gave an update on the Homelessness Services Coordinator, who was just hired by the City.

6. Minnehaha County Update - Logan Penfield

Logan gave the update sent by Kari Benz (conflicting meeting).

They shared with the group a quick update on progress made on the Just Home Project and the purchase of the Copper Arms building.

7. City of Sioux Falls General Housing Update (Shana Nelson)

Shana Nelson formally announced the results of the recently submitted Consolidated Annual Performance Evaluation Report (CAPER).

In short, the City of Sioux Falls expended \$5.4 million and impacted nearly 3,000 individuals through our various housing programs and partnerships.

8. Tax Abatement Draft Ordinance (Dustin Powers)

Dustin Powers gave an overview of the new draft of potential city policy on tax abatement for affordable housing. This was the same presentation that was given at the April 2, 2024, City Council Informational Meeting and Minnehaha County Commission Meeting (can be viewed online).

The presentation led to several board questions but ultimately no changes to the draft of qualifying projects.
