John Beranek of Intersections Consulting and SculptureWalk joined the VAC meeting to discuss the Charlotte Carver Gallery at City Hall. He spoke about Charlotte Carver's legacy and the background behind creating a space to showcase local artists at City Hall. The space has not been effectively programmed in many years, and the initial intent was to rotate art in that space multiple times a year. John encourages the VAC to rethink the current structure of the Carver Gallery and explore ways to better showcase that space. The VAC noted that it is a struggle to get artists interested in showcasing there since there are no dollars tied to the selection and the building is closed in the evening and weekends. The VAC will be working on a new strategic plan for the space in the hopes of revitalizing it in 2026 – exploring the possibility of securing donors for a cash prize for the juried shows.
