HISTORY IN THE MAKING



South Dakota's Biennial Certified Local Government (CLG) Conference is an opportunity for the regional preservation community to convene for networking and continuing education. Join us in May as we celebrate "History in the Making" with the 50 Year Anniversary of the Cathedral Historic District, the first residential historic district designated in the state of South Dakota.

As history continues to be made in cities across South Dakota, our featured keynote speaker will provide in-depth analysis and research of the economic impacts of historic preservation. Native South Dakotan, Donovan Rypkema, principal of PlaceEconomics, a real estate and economic development consulting firm in Washington D.C., will provide insight into his expertise and knowledge of how historic preservation and rehabilitation of downtowns, neighborhoods, and commercial districts produces positive economic impacts for communities.

Tours of key areas and districts in Sioux Falls will provide you with a first hand glimpse of the impacts historic preservation and revitalization have on our community. The History of East Sioux Falls will be seen at the Mary Jo Arboretum site, a Pettigrew Home and Museum Tour, a walking tour of the Cathedral Historic District and select homes, and an Historic Scavenger Hunt in Downtown Sioux Falls will provide ample opportunities to explore these historic landmarks and buildings.

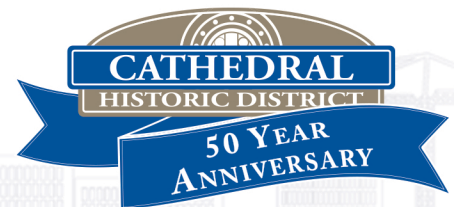
