INTRODUCTION

Lawrence & Schiller partnered with the City of Sioux Falls in June 2019 to gather public opinion regarding current and future uses of the Events Campus facilities. With a goal of gathering 400 total completed responses, the survey was scheduled to run June 6 – June 11, 2019. As of June 11, the survey had generated more than 600 (n=640) responses to be analyzed and shared with the Panel at its scheduled meeting on June 26. This report is available on the City of Sioux Fall website: https://www.siouxfalls.org/mayor/events-center-study-group/survey-results. Due to the high level of public interest and response rates, the survey remained open to collect responses through June 18.

The following document provides raw data tables which include a side-by-side comparison of the sample used in the June 26 report, as well as the response data that was collected after the June 11 cutoff for analysis and reporting. Each crosstabulation provides the frequency distribution of responses for the total sample results (shown in the first column), results used in the June 26 report (second column), and the results that were collected in the days following the June 11 cutoff (third column).

Statistical overview of study sample:

- Total sample (n=1,271)
 - June 6 18, 2019 (full duration of survey fieldwork)
 - Confidence interval: ±2.75%, at 95% confidence level
- June Report to Panel (n=640)
 - June 6 11, 2019
 - Confidence interval: ±3.87%, at 95% confidence level
- Remaining sample (n=631)
 - June 11 18, 2019
 - Confidence interval: ±3.90%, at 95% confidence level

Additional notes:

- Varying sample size, by question. Certain survey questions were displayed based on condition of prior question
 responses. For example, respondents who have not attended a recent event at the Sioux Falls Stadium were not asked
 detailed perception questions about the stadium. Therefore, in instances where the sample size provided for the question
 does not total 1,271, table frequencies have been calculated based on the valid sample size of respondents who were
 presented with the question.
- Multiple response questions. The survey included several questions in which respondents were able to record more than
 one response, e.g., "select all that apply." These questions are denoted throughout this document as "Multiple Response."
 Such tables contain two statistics per variable. The first, % Valid Cases, shows the frequency (percentage) of the given
 response based on the total number of respondents who answered the question, and percentages will typically sum to
 greater than 100%. The second statistic, % Total Mentions, shows the response as a percentage of all responses provided
 across the valid sample.
