

Sioux Falls Board of Health Resolution
April 12th, 2018

The undersigned, Elizabeth Donohue Wheeler, the duly elected chairperson of the Board of Health for the City of Sioux Falls, hereby certifies that Lisa Stensland, who is the secretary of the Board of Health responsible for keeping records of the meetings of the Board of Health has reviewed the minutes of the Board of Health meeting held on April 18, 2018, a true and correct copy of which is attached to this certificate, and has confirmed that a resolution to approve the definition of a “qualified person” as referenced in Section 90.013 of the Sioux Falls City Ordinance, a copy of which is attached hereto, was approved. The undersigned did not attend the April 12, 2018 Board meeting as she was not a member of the Board at that time, however Lisa Stensland did attend that meeting and she has confirmed that additional Animal Industry board criteria, as follows were deemed to apply to a qualified person:

- 1) Key staff members, as determined by a licensed veterinarian, which had received training by the licensed veterinarian regarding rabies vaccine handling, rabies vaccine administration and appropriate record keeping, would be considered “qualified”.
- 2) The necessary records must include date, location, and route of administration; vaccine product name, serial number and expiration date; the duration of immunity, one or three years, based on previous vaccine history; and rabies tag number and expiration date
- 3) The licensed veterinarian must be willing to oversee all training and maintain accountability and appropriate documentation for all rabies vaccinations given, should an animal’s vaccine status be called into question.
