Report of Director of Parks and Recreation:

Brett Kollars started the report by mentioning there were over 6,600 visitors to Jacobson Plaza this weekend. Kollars shared that the City is providing a temporary construction easement to support Jacobson Plaza Phase 2 development, allowing the contractor to store materials ahead

of construction starting. Kollars noted that the partnership with the City of Sioux Falls, State of South Dakota and Smithfield is welcoming news. Kollars mentioned that six bids came in for the Kuehn Park Family Aquatics Center. The bid was expected at 15.4 million and the low bid came in at 13.2 million. Kollars noted this will allow for some if not all alternates that includes things such as extra water area, extra water slide, etc. Kollars mentioned that the CommuniTree program will kick off as soon as weather allows with 1,200 plantings in our underserved neighborhoods. Kollars mentioned that seasonal hiring is going well for both operations and recreation. Finally, Kollars replied to a questions from Cauwels, Kollars stated that the tree removal at Cliff and I-29 is in regard to a Public Works project to make room for water compensatory storage. Parks and Recreation has already replanted back 200 trees.
