Meeting Minutes

ITEM 1. Call to Order and Quorum Determination:

Chairperson Joe Schaeffer called the meeting to order at 9:01 am.

ITEM 3. Approval of Regular Agenda:

Commissioner Dickson made the motion to approve the regular agenda and Commissioner Jamison seconded the motion. The agenda was approved unanimously.

ITEM 4. Approval of Minutes from September 19, 2023, Regular Meeting:

Commissioner Boice made the motion to approve the minutes with the noted correction to item 7b. It was \$7,250 in lieu of \$17,000 awarded in micro grants to artists last quarter. Commissioner Dickson seconded the motion. The minutes were approved unanimously.

ITEM 6. Unfinished Business:

a) Repair and Maintenance of Obtuse.

Obtuse was reinstalled a week ago. On review by staff, there are areas where bare steel is exposed, multiple areas of paint drips and inconsistent paint color. Cameron, with the Pavilion has contacted Luverne Body Shop that they contracted with for the repairs. The Body Shop has agreed to correct the work.

b) Elk sculpture vandalism

On Tuesday, October 17 Artist, Travis Sorenson sent an email asking if a friend can pick up the Elk Sculpture to have it brought back to Sturgis for the repairs. Travis will have time in approximately three weeks to replace the copper.

ITEM 7. New Business:

a) Sculpture Walk Review

Commissioners reviewed various sculptures with a recommendation for consideration to Cameron at the Pavilion.

b) Sioux Falls Arts Council Update

\$7,250 in mini-grants will be awarded in November to various artists.

The Arts Council was awarded \$20,000 from the SFACF to have ArtSpace come to Sioux Falls for a feasibility study. The award was \$20,000 short of the \$40,000 price tag for the study so the Arts Council will defer the study until they have all the funds available.
