Movie Theater Life-Safety Checklist

The following Fire Code requirements are specific for **Movie Theater** occupancies and should be used as a *supplement* to the "**Commercial Business Fire and Life-Safety Checklist**".

<u>Fire Extinguishers</u>			
		One 2A:10BC (5 lb.) fire extinguisher per 75 feet of travel.	
		Extinguisher mounted no higher than 5 feet above the floor to the top of the handle	
	_	and be visible.	
	Ц	Extinguishers serviced and tagged <u>annually</u> by a third party.	
Fire Sprinklers			
		Is the Fire Suppression (Sprinkler) System maintained, inspected, cleaned, and tested at least <u>annually</u> by a Fire Protection Systems contractor (including manual and automatic system components)?	
		No decoration or attachments are allowed on sprinkler piping or heads. Defective sprinkler heads (bent, corroded, painted) shall be replaced. 18-inch clearance required below sprinkler heads.	
		Are maintenance and testing records maintained at the facility available for review by the Fire Department?	
		Are spare sprinkler heads / wrench present in a cabinet near the sprinkler risers? Is there a sign on the door to the sprinkler control room that reads "Sprinkler Riser"?	
Fire Alarm Systems (If equipped)			
		Is your system maintained and tested on a <i>quarterly</i> basis? Is there a sign on the door to the room that contains the fire alarm panel that reads "Fire Alarm"?	
Exiting – Doors, Signs and Aisles			
		Fire doors must be maintained, self-closing and latch from the full open position. Exit doors, aisles, corridors and stairs are free of obstructions and storage. Do Exit/Egress Doors have prohibited locking mechanisms such as special fasteners, chains, or deadbolts?	
Exit Signs			
		Exit signs are illuminated and the battery backup functions properly. Emergency lights operate.	

☐ Does storage, furnishings, or decorations obscure the Exit signs?

☐ Are the Exit Lights inspected, and tested on a monthly basis?
 Emergency Lighting/Egress Lighting □ Does the facility have emergency egress lighting with battery back-up capability? □ Are the Emergency Egress Lights inspected, and tested on a monthly basis? □ Does storage, furnishings, or decorations obscure the Emergency Egress Lights?
 Electrical Safety □ Does your facility have bare bulbs, exposed wiring, outlet/junction box cover plates missing, altered circuit breaker panels, or unlabeled electrical panels? □ Power strips are UL listed and plugged directly into permanent outlets? □ Do you have extension cords being utilized in lieu of permanent wiring? □ Extension cords are plugged directly into permanent outlets. □ Extension cords and power strips are not affixed to structures, run through walls ceilings, floors, and doorways or under rugs. □ 36-inches of clearance in front of all electrical panels. □ Panels and electrical boxes must have covers – no exposed electrical wiring.
Housekeeping ☐ Storage is orderly. ☐ Are materials/goods being stored too close to the ceiling? (Unsprinklered Areas - 24" Clearance, Sprinklered Areas - 18" clearance) ☐ Is the storage of materials or commodities blocking access to fire protection systems or equipment (Blocked sprinkler control valves, blocked standpipe connections, blocked fire extinguisher cabinets)? ☐ Are materials being stored within 48" of a gas-fired appliance (water heater, furnace? ☐ Combustible material cannot be stored in boiler rooms, mechanical rooms or electrical equipment rooms. ☐ Are gasoline-powered items being stored inside the facility with fuel in the tanks? ☐ 4" minimum tall address numbers visible from the street that stands out from the background.
Fire Lanes/Fire Hydrants/Fire Department Connections □ Does the facility have Fire Lane Areas that have been or need designated by the Fire Department for Emergency Vehicle Access? □ Are the Fire Lane areas properly identified with signs? □ Are there storage items, trash containers, storage containers, or vehicles blocking access to Fire Hydrants, Fire Department Connections or Fire lanes?
 Key Boxes (Emergency Fire Department Access Key Boxes) - [] Present [] Not Present □ As the Facility Manager or Business Owner have you contacted the Fire Prevention Division to request a "Locking Key Box" application? □ Have you contacted your local Fire Prevention Division for additional information
