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Fire and Life-Safety Checklist: **Educational Occupancies**

The following Fire Code requirements are specific for <u>Educational</u> occupancies and should be used as a <u>supplement</u> to the "Commercial Business Fire and Life-Safety Checklist".

Fire S	Safety and Evacuation Plans/Fire Drills
	An approved fire safety and evacuation plan shall be prepared and maintained.
	Evacuation Drills shall be conducted four times per school year with all occupants
	participating.
	The first emergency evacuation drill of each school year shall be conducted within 10 days of the beginning of classes.
	A log recording the date of such drills shall be kept on the premises.
	Emergency evacuation plans shall be conspicuously posted in classroom and assembly areas.
Deco	rative items
	The hanging and displaying of decorative materials from acoustical ceiling systems
	that are part of a fire-resistance-rated floor/ceiling or roof/ceiling assembly shall be
_	prohibited. 703.3
Ц	Artwork and teaching materials shall be limited on the walls of corridors to not more than 20 percent of the wall area. 807.4.4.2
	Curtains, draperies, hangings and other decorative materials suspended from walls or ceilings shall meet the flame propagation performance criteria of NFPA 701 in
	accordance with Section 806.2 or be noncombustible. 807.1
Ц	The following items are not allowed in the building: Natural cut trees. 806.1.1
	 Natural cut trees. 806.1.7 Furnishings or decorative materials of an explosive or highly flammable
	character. 807.4.1
	Clothing and personal effects shall not be stored in corridors and lobbies unless 1) the
	corridor is protected by either an approved automatic sprinkler system or smoke
	detection system, or 2) storage items are in metal lockers, (provided the minimum
	required egress width is maintained). 807.4.3.1

Commercial Kitchen Hood Systems

 □ Class K extinguishers shall be located within 30 feet of commercial cooking equipment involving solid fuels or vegetable or animal oils and fats; or if equipped with deep fat fryers (one Class K portable fire extinguisher of a minimum 1.5 gallon capacity is required for every 4 fryers (maximum cooking medium capacity of the fryers = 80 pounds each)).
