# Fire & Life-Safety Checklist: Service Stations

The following Fire Code requirements are specific for **Service Station** occupancies and should be used as a *supplement* to the "**Commercial Business Fire and Life-Safety Checklist**".

TANK MONITORING	PANEL
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□ Panel must be on and operating and supplied with paper.
□ If any alarm or warning is on a call to maintenance must be made.
□ If a sump sensor alarms the sump must be visually inspected by a qualified person.
□ Records must be kept for a minimum of 1 year. Copy of leak test records must be kept on-site, even if sent to home office. COPY MUST BE ON SITE.

### FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

☐ Extinguishers must be inspected and tagged by 3<sup>rd</sup> party annually.

## FIRE ALARM AND FIRE SPRINKLERS

☐ If present, they must be inspected and tagged by qualified 3<sup>rd</sup> party.

## **MEANS OF EGRESS**

- ☐ Exit doors, aisles, corridors and stairs are free of obstructions and storage.
- ☐ Exit and egress doors are prohibited from having special locking mechanisms that could delay an emergency egress such as special fasteners, chains, or deadbolts.
- ☐ Exit signs are visible, illuminated and the battery backup functions properly.
- ☐ Emergency lights are visible and operate.

#### **GENERAL FIRE SAFETY**

☐ Extension cords cannot be used as substitute for permanent wiring.

#### **PERSONNEL**

☐ All workers must have appropriate Tank Operator Training.
