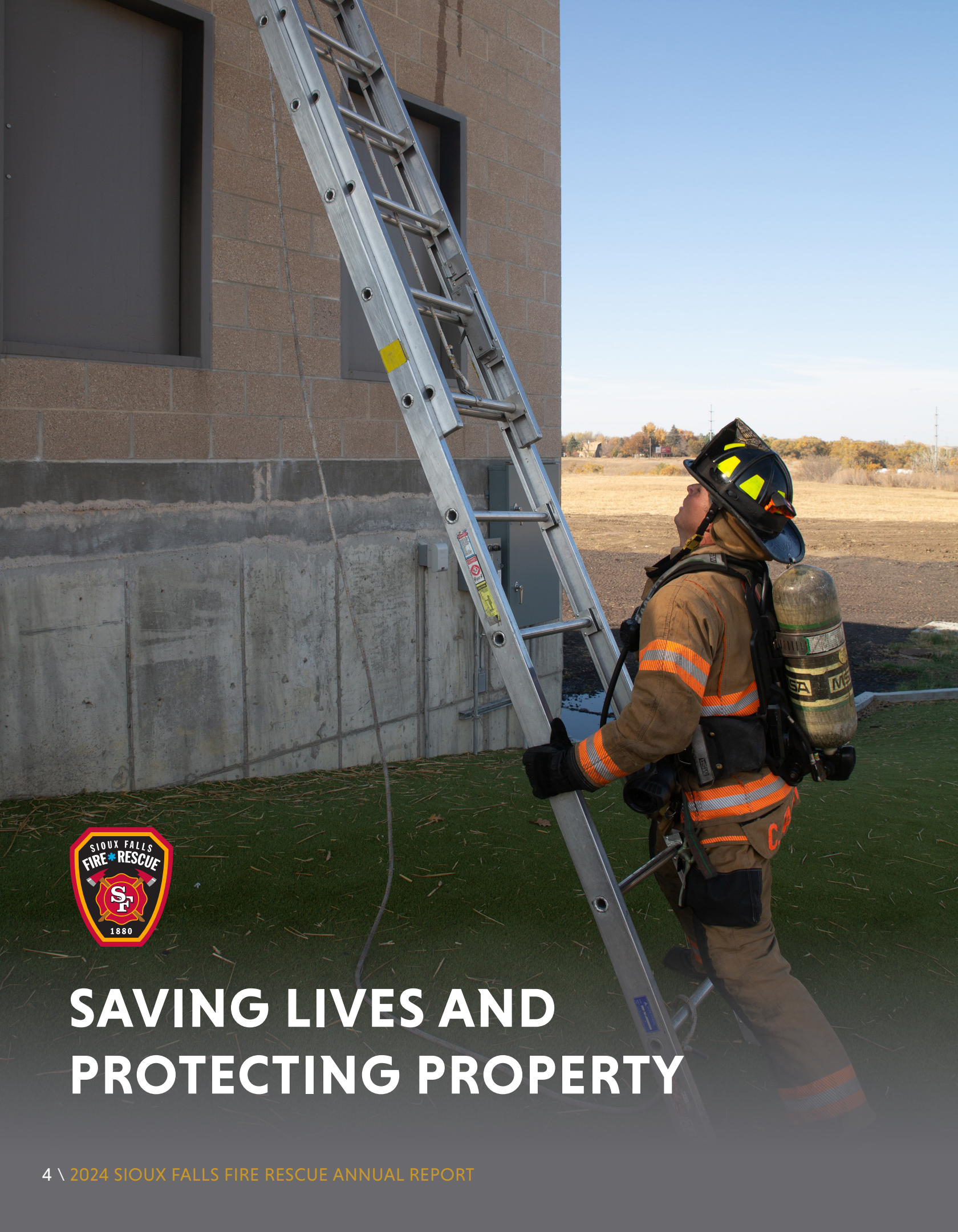

OUR PURPOSE

Sioux Falls Fire Rescue is committed to protecting the people and property of our community from hazards and emergencies. Through public education, inspection, code enforcement, and fire investigation, SFFR provides a full range of services, while continuing to foster a culture of community risk reduction. If you have experienced or witnessed a traumatic event such as a car accident, medical emergency, fire, or rescue, you have seen first hand the professionalism and expertise of Sioux Falls Fire Rescue.

OUR FOCUS

- Invest in training and growth in employee health initiatives
- Invest in current facilities by repairing and remodeling fire stations to keep up with 24/7/365 utilization
- Work with the Sioux Falls Police Department and Metro 911 on the first full year of Public Safety Campus operations
- Work with community and regional partners to mitigate and prevent loss through risk reduction efforts
- This will be accomplished by investing time, energy, and money into firefighter health and wellness initiatives, constructing an additional fire station in 2026-2027, and continuing to build relationships with community partners through education, and programs to keep residents safe from preventable incidents.

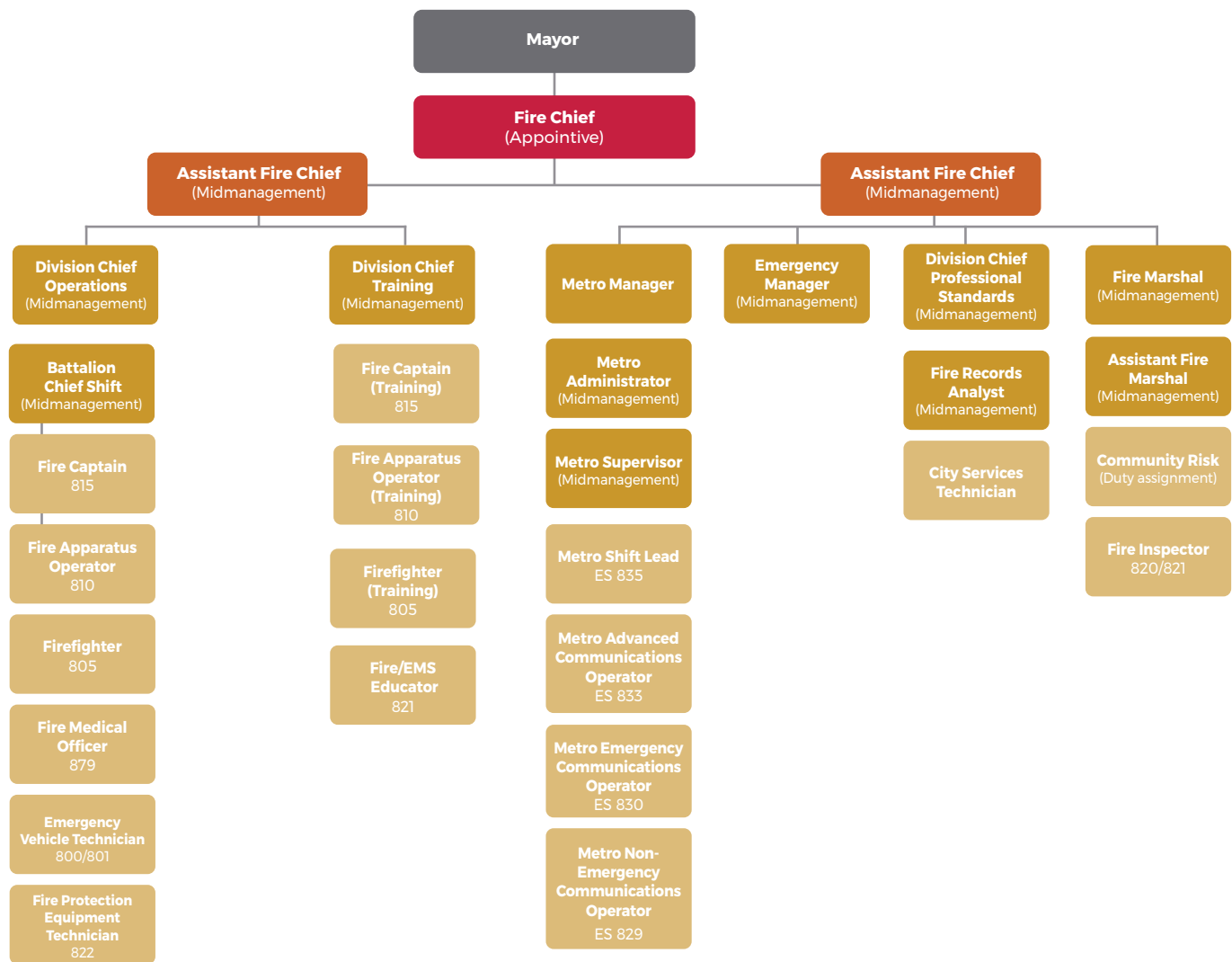

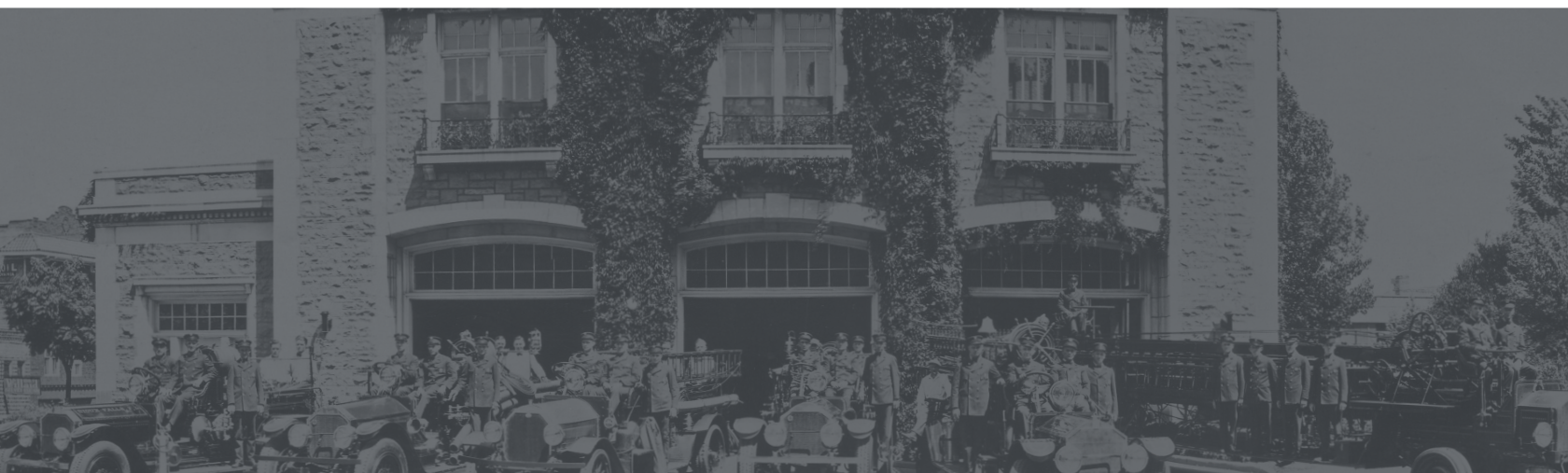


SFFR ORGANIZATIONAL CHART



MAJOR OPERATING BUDGET IMPACTS

Revenues	<p>\$120,000 increase in expected Fire Insurance Premium Reversion based on trends.</p> <p>\$25,000 increase for offsetting reimbursements for purchases of lockboxes.</p>
Total Personnel	<p>\$2,176,707 increase for normal full-time wages and benefits adjustments and the addition of one Fire Training Captain.</p>
Professional Services	<p>\$18,000 increase for annual physicals, testing, and wellness services.</p> <p>\$17,000 increase due to a City-wide adjustment in internal property liability and risk charges.</p>
Rentals	<p>\$172,000 increase due to a City-wide adjustment in internal technology rental charges for cyclic replacement, security, and network enhancements.</p>
Repair and Maintenance	<p>\$80,000 increase for service and maintenance of new fire training prop.</p> <p>\$61,000 increase due to centralized facilities charges for ongoing facilities improvements.</p> <p>\$37,000 increase due to adjustments and cost increases for SCBA equipment, EMS equipment, PPE, and radios.</p> <p>\$125,000 increase due to adjustments and cost increases, including for fire hose, EMS supplies, PPE, emergency response equipment, and miscellaneous supplies.</p> <p>\$32,000 increase for software and analytics, particularly for exposure tracking and injury/loss prevention.</p>

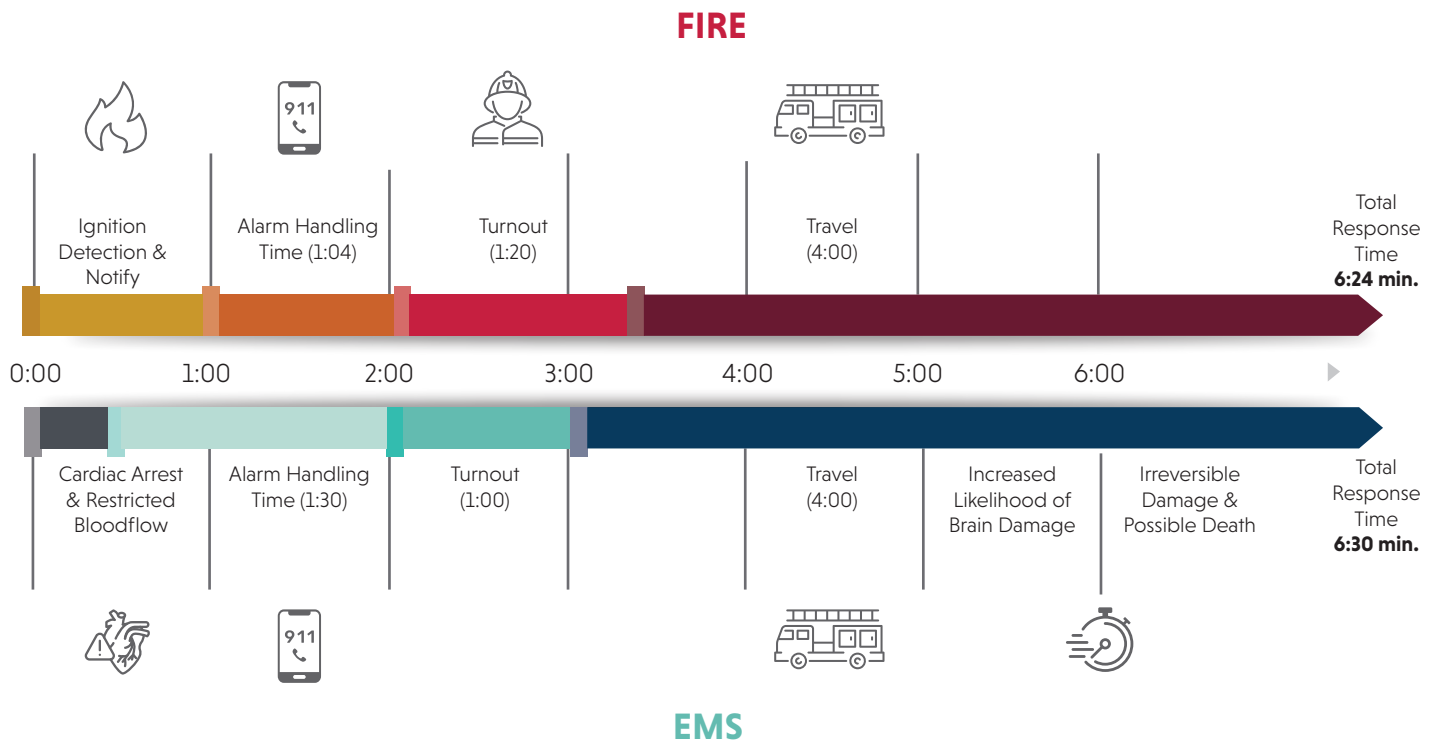

BASELINE RESPONSE TIME FOR FIRE & EMS

90% of priority calls have a Turnout Time of **1:31** (Turnout Time: The time interval that begins when the emergency response facility and emergency response unit's notification process begins by either an audible alarm or visual announcement or both and ends at the beginning point of travel time.)

90% of priority calls have a Travel Time of **4:55** (Travel Time: The time interval that begins when a unit is in route to the emergency incident and ends when the unit arrives at the scene.)

90% of priority calls have a Total Response Time of **9:43** (Total Response Time: The time interval from the receipt of the alarm at the agency public safety answering point to when the first emergency response unit is initiating action or intervening to control the incident.)

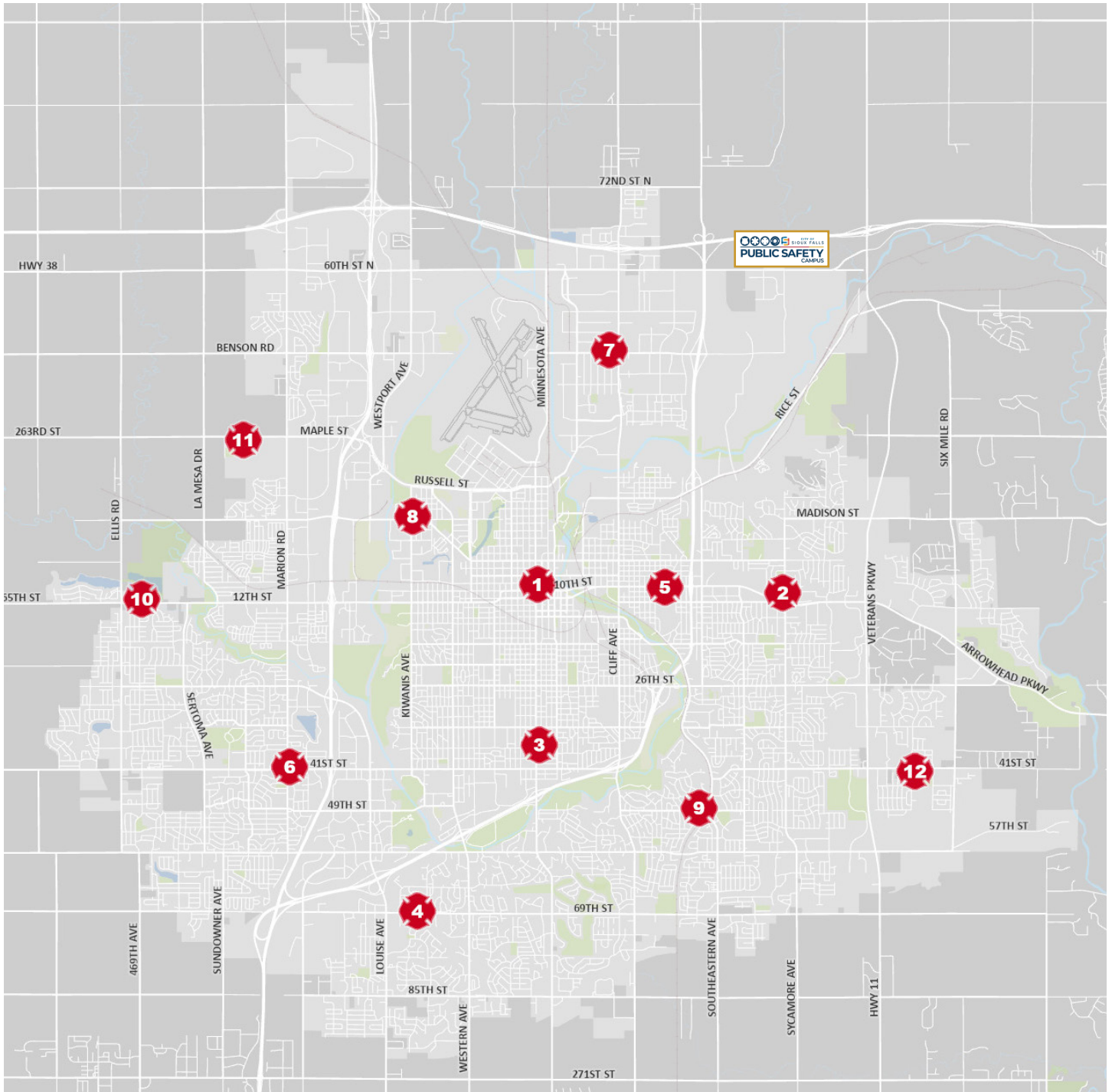

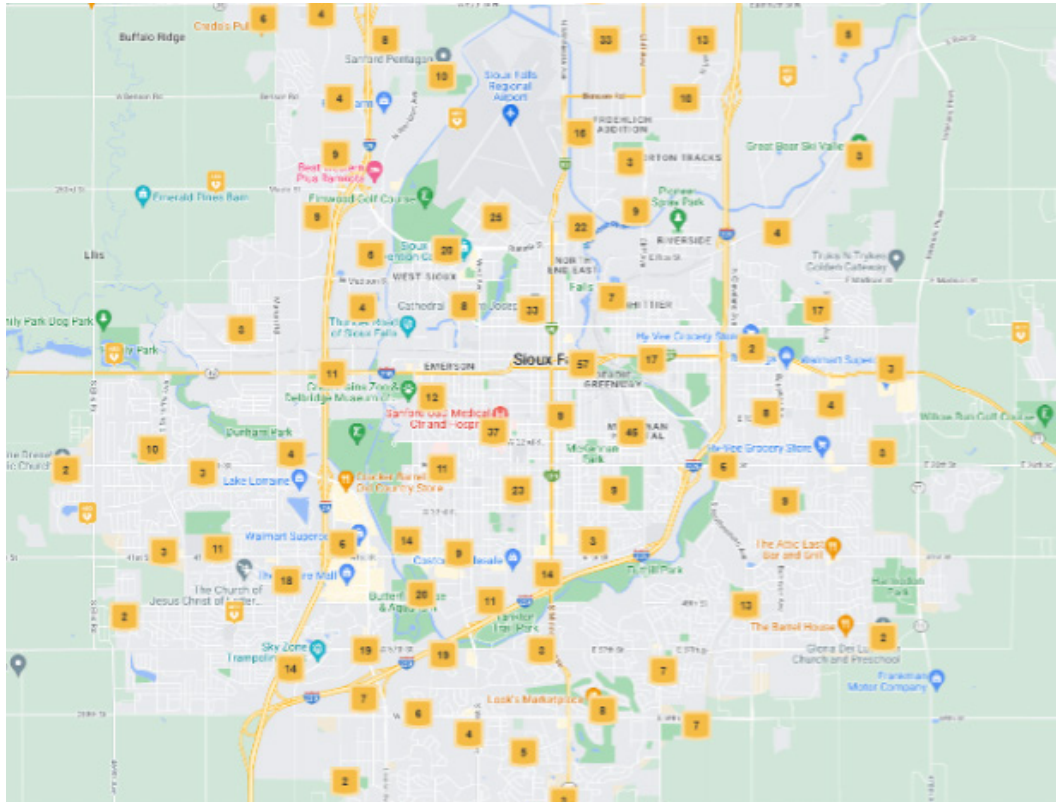
COMMUNITY RISK REDUCTION/ FIRE PREVENTION

The public access defibrillator (PADs) program started in 2003 and continues to be an important part of keeping Sioux Falls and other communities Heart Safe.

A vital component in survivability comes through awareness and training in CPR and AED use.

- **1,542** individuals were trained through SFFR's community-based education
- **752** CPR Certifications
- **791** Individuals were trained in hands-only CPR

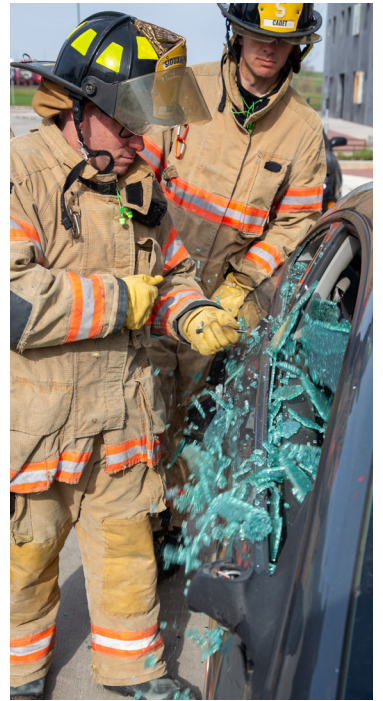
