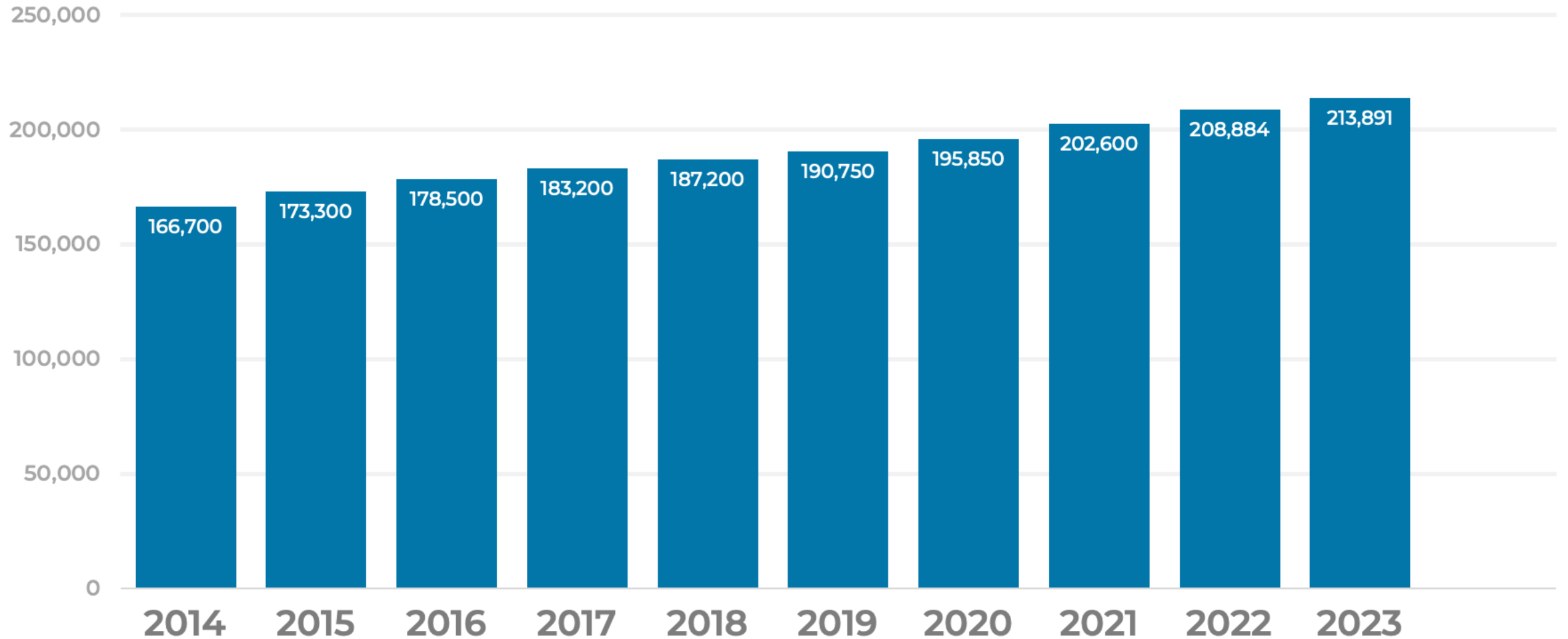

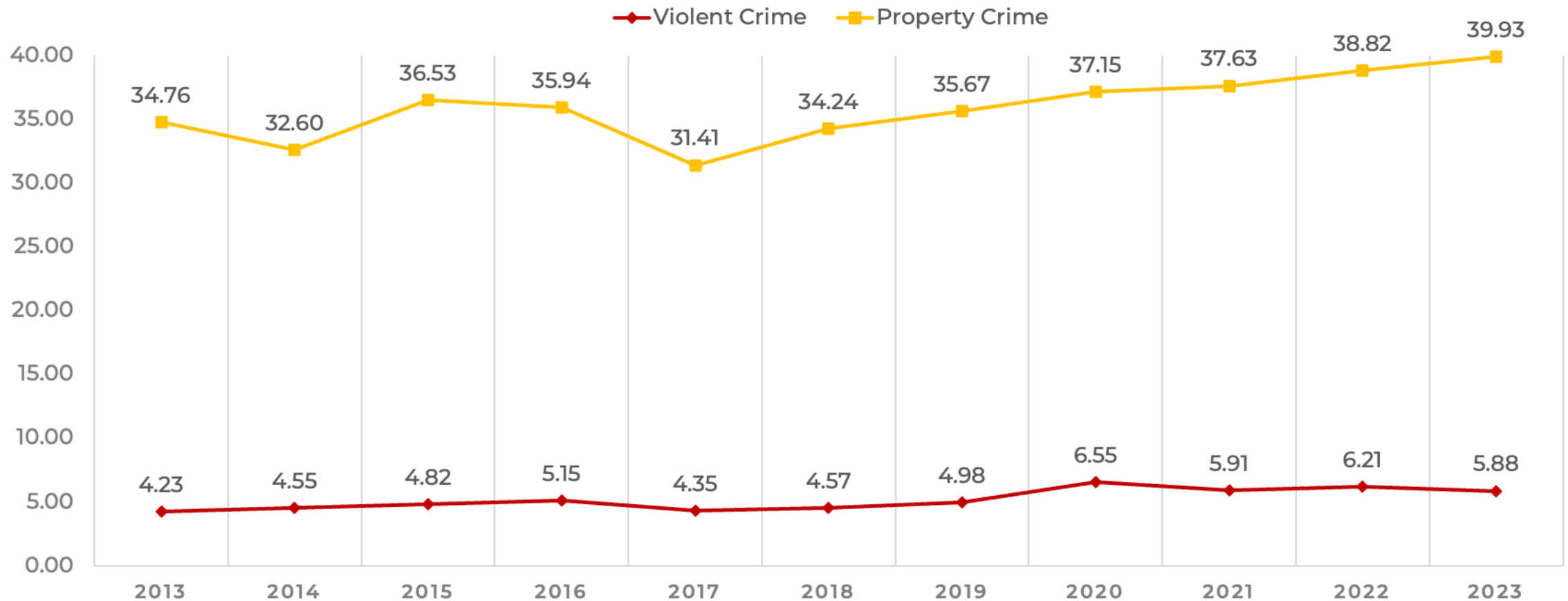

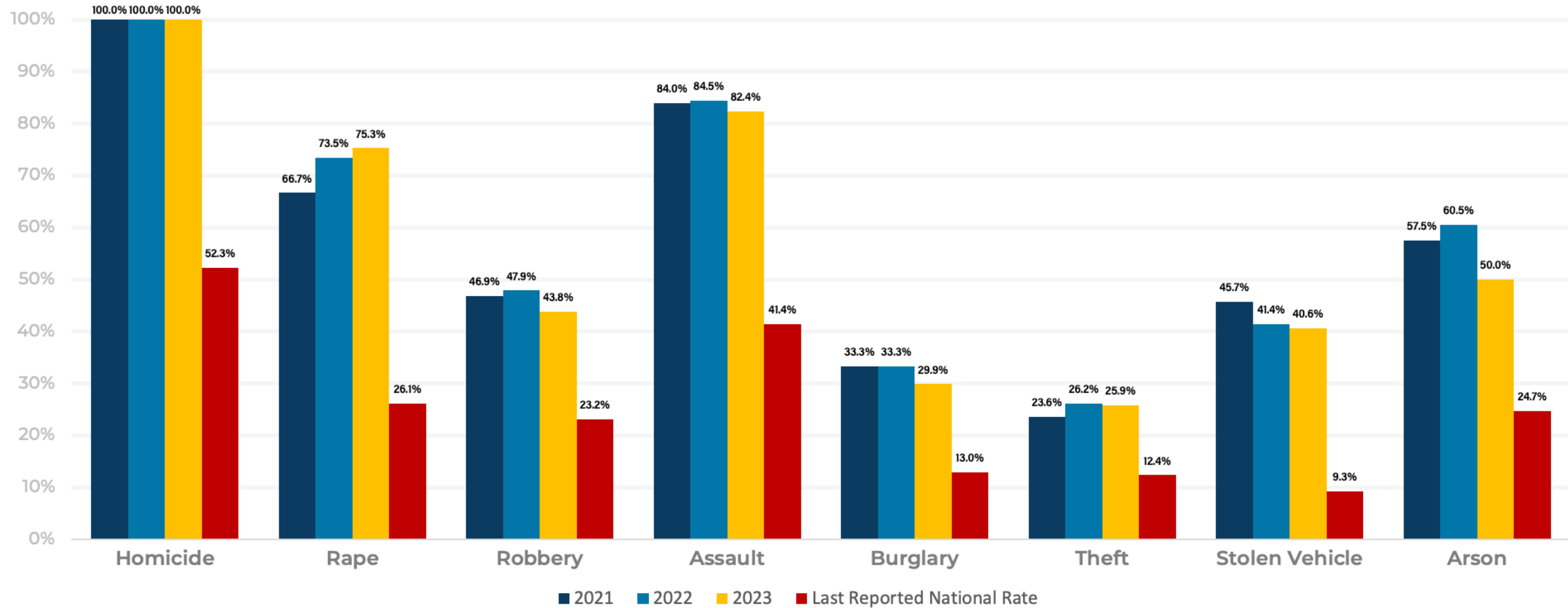
Population

City Clearance Rates





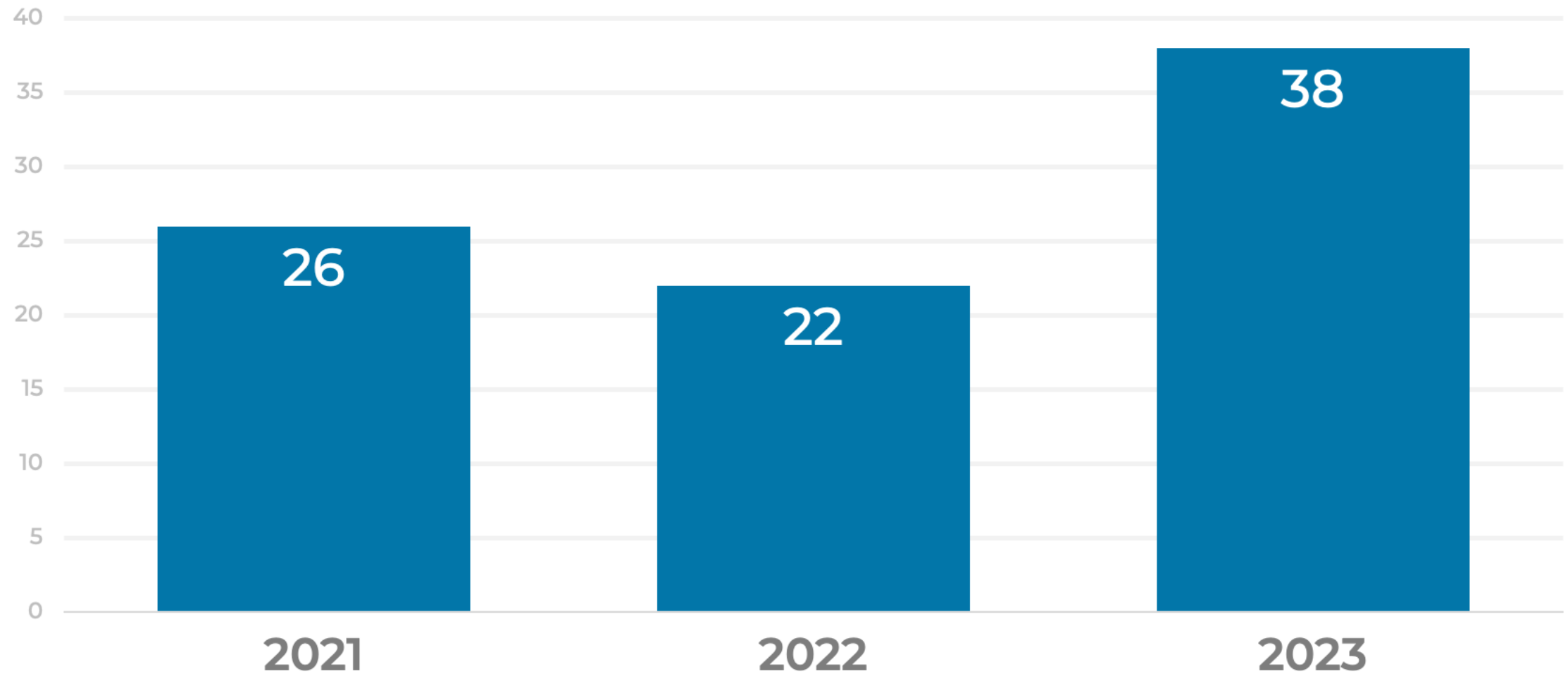

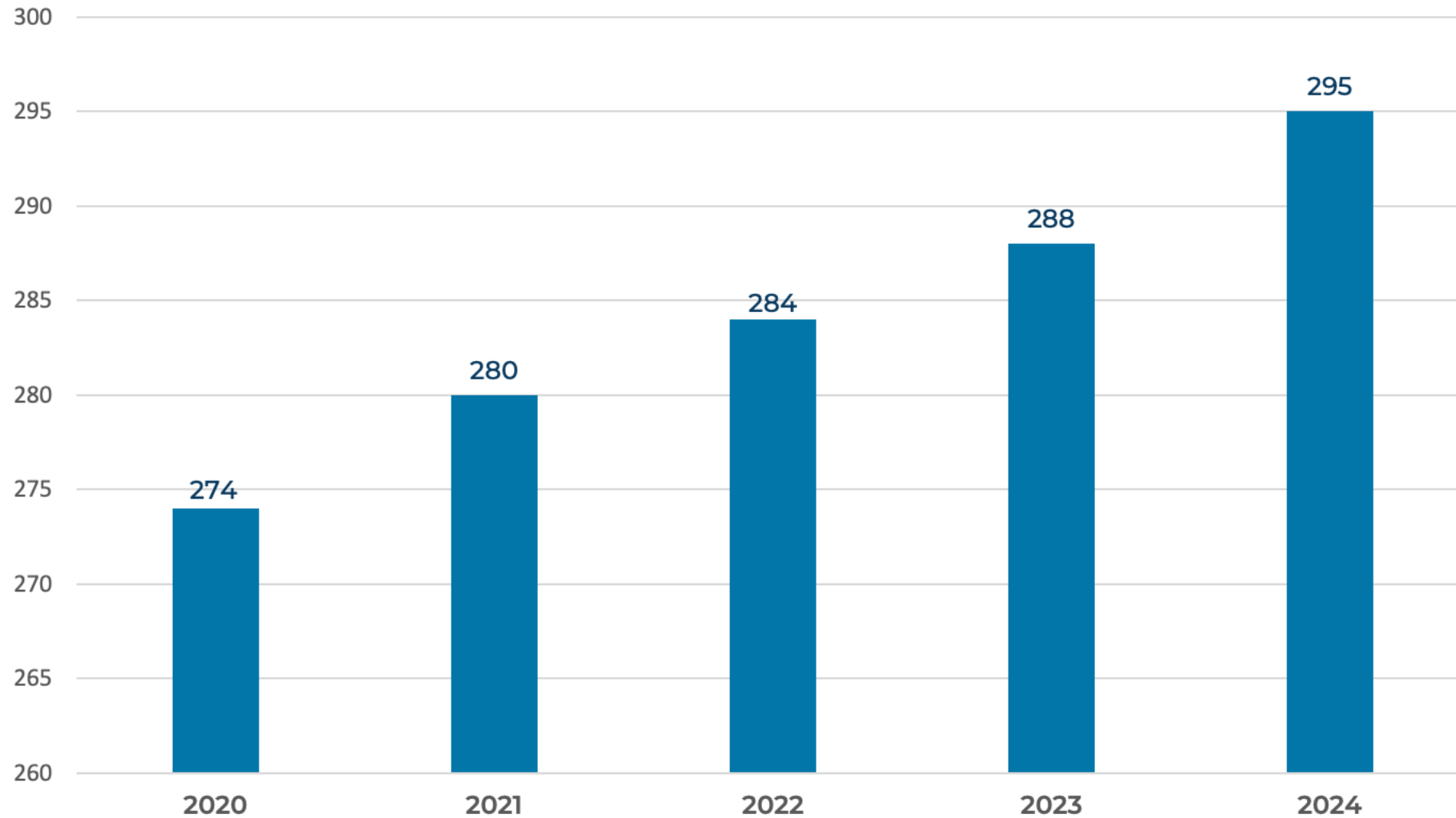

Chinese pharmaceutical companies are the primary source of fentanyl precursors and fentanyl trafficked into the United States. Information from the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) indicates the Jalisco and Sinaloa cartels are the primary drug trafficking organizations responsible for smuggling fentanyl into the United States from Mexico.

Sinaloa and Jalisco Cartels Distribution Network

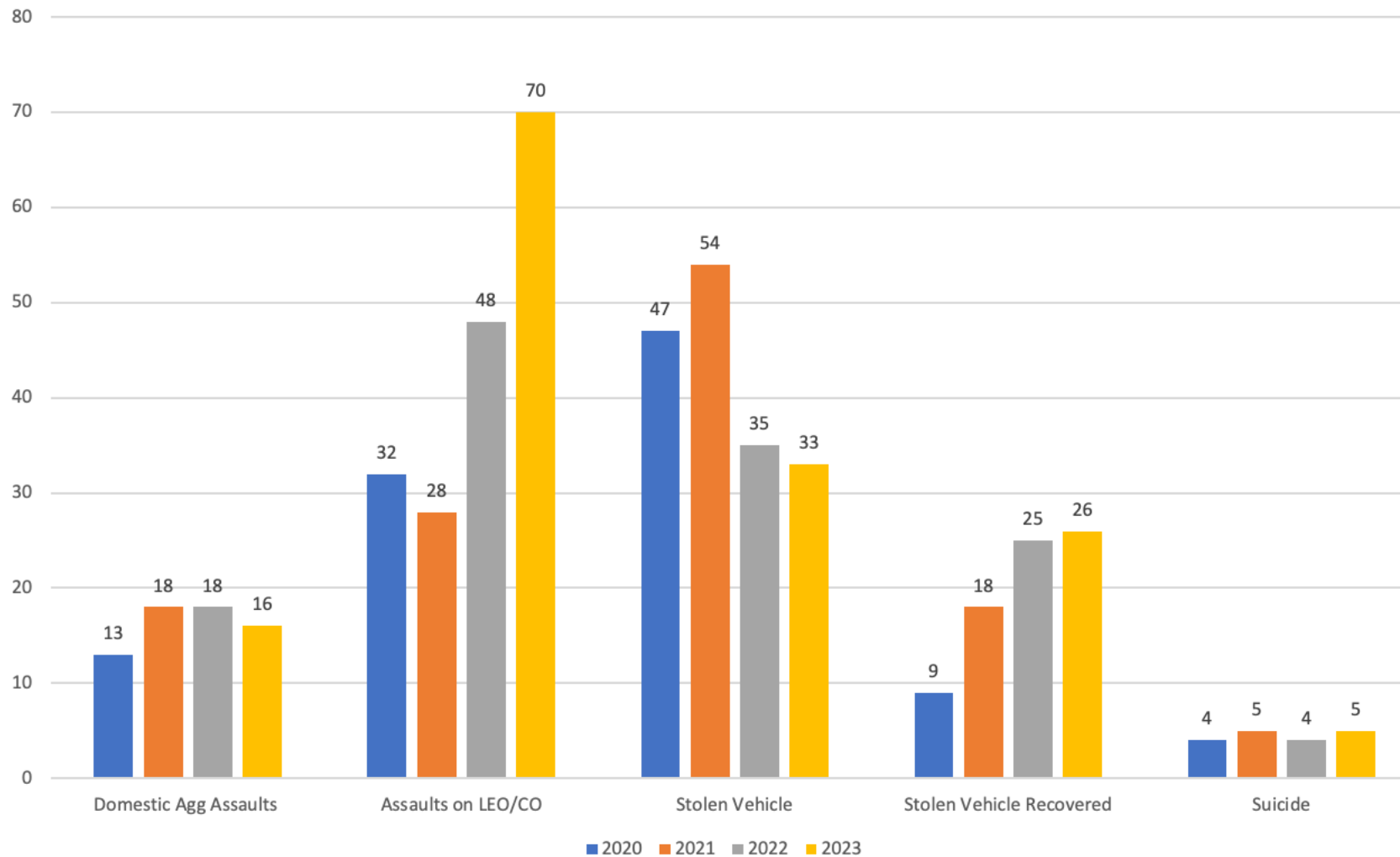


During the fiscal year 2023, the United States Customs and Border Protection reported they had seized 27,000 pounds of fentanyl, 26,700 pounds from the Southwest Border Region alone. These seizures represent approximately **6,055,453,200** potentially lethal doses of fentanyl; 2 milligrams of fentanyl equates to a potentially deadly dose. In addition to these seizures, the DEA reported the seizure of 79,400,000 fentanyl-laced counterfeit pills and almost 12,000 pounds of fentanyl powder; these seizures translate to more than **379,900,000** lethal doses of fentanyl.

The Minnehaha County Jail



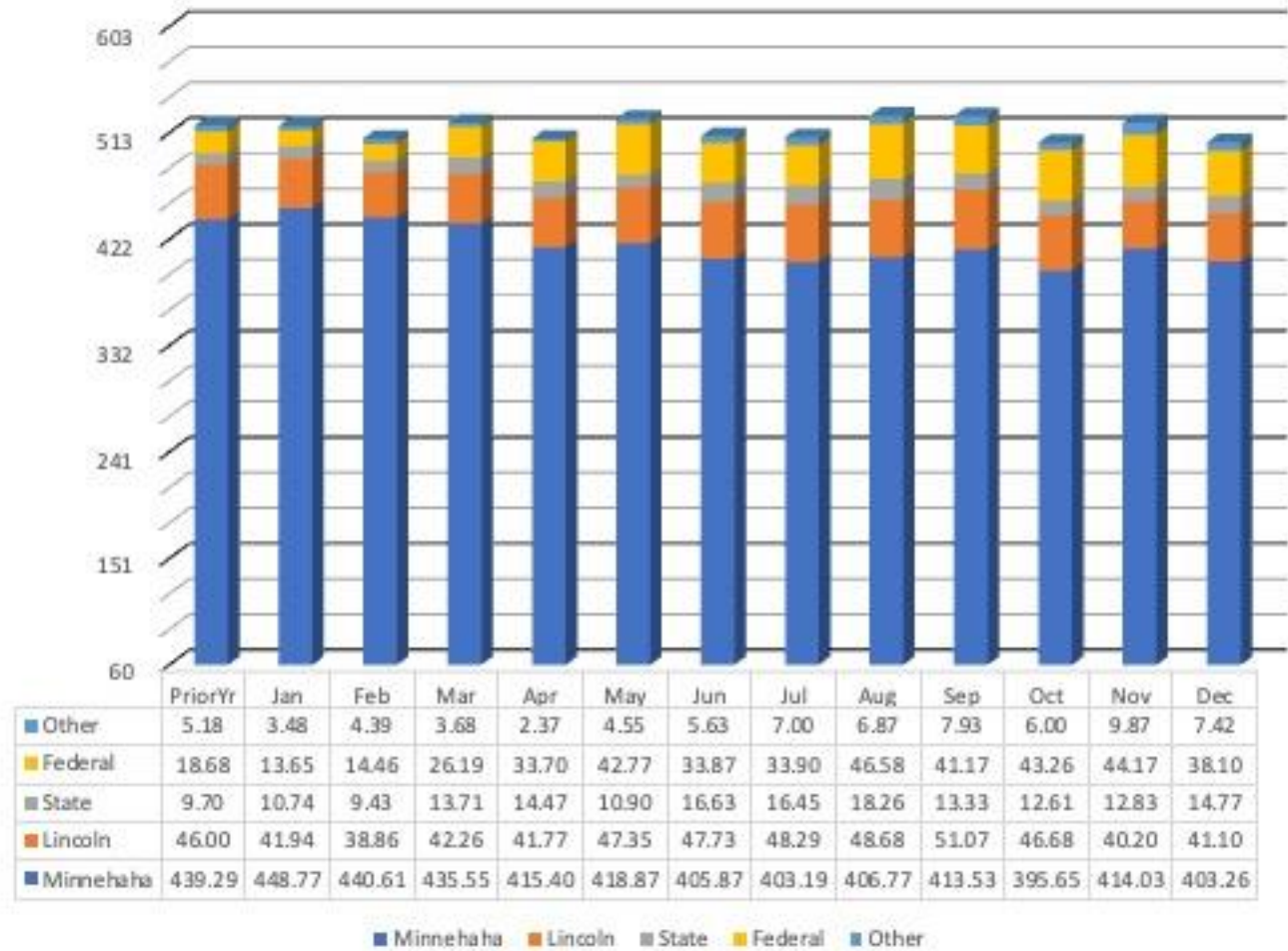
- Has a current capacity of 603 beds
 - There is one 148 bed floor that is vacant.
 - Planning for occupying the vacant floor has started. Occupying this floor in its full capacity requires roughly 36 additional staff that would have to be hired.
 - Once the vacant floor is occupied, the maximum capacity of the facility will be 751.
 - The operational capacity of the Jail is 513 inmates or 85% of the total number of beds. This allows for peaking and classification. Higher population over the weekends and ensuring that inmates are housed appropriately.



Average Daily Population

- The average daily population in 2023 was 518.
 - On average this consists of:
 - 417 Minnehaha County Inmates
 - 45 Lincoln County inmates
 - 35 Federal Inmates
 - 11 SD Parole inmates
 - 10 Other County Inmates

2023 ADP by Month

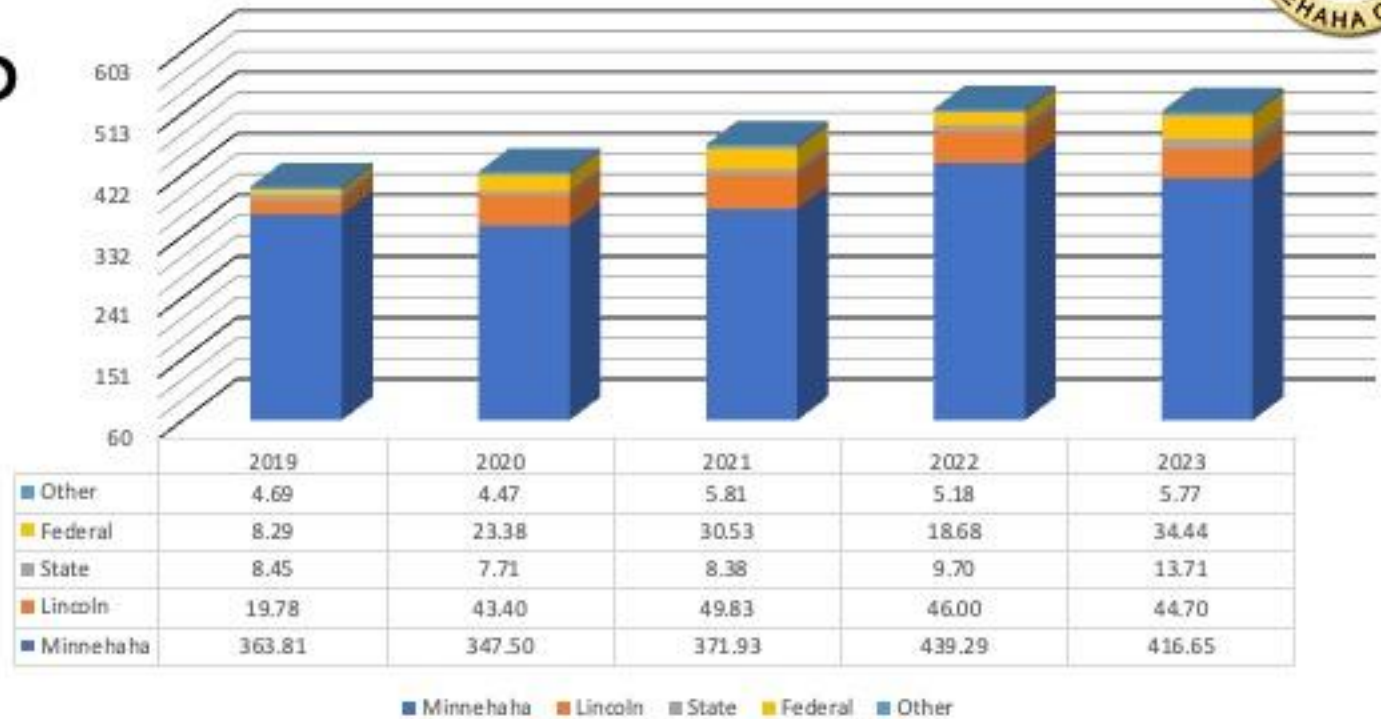




Continuous Monitoring of ADP

- Inmate population trends are continuously being evaluated to determine when the vacant floor will need to be utilized and when the additional staff will have to be recruited and hired.
- Looking at our current trends, the inmate population is below projections which allows the County to delay growing into the unoccupied Jail space.
- The ability to delay occupying the available space in the Jail is a direct result of programs like PreTrial Services and continued work with in the Justice system to SAFELY maintain the Jail population as low as possible.
- This saves the County a very significant cost in staffing expenses.

Minnehaha County Jail Programs



- 24/7 Program
 - Currently has 340 participants.
- Electronic Monitoring Program
 - Currently has 47 participants.
- Pre Trial Services
 - Currently has 236 participants.
 - Pretrial Services produces the Public Safety Assessment (PSA) for initial appearances in both circuit and magistrate courts. These are used in determining bond and provide objective and accurate info to the court for defendants charged with crimes that carry the consequence of potential jail or prison time.
 - Pretrial Services provides monitoring and supervision of defendants during the pretrial phase of their cases as a condition of bond.
 - A third facet of Pretrial Services is the sharing of resource information with defendants as well as referrals and connections between Pretrial and other community programs.
