#### **Attachment 10: Parks and Recreation Tobacco-Free Policy**

### **Policy Statement**

The City of Sioux Falls is committed to the quality of life for all residents. Therefore, we believe that:

- Tobacco product use in proximity of children, youth, and adults engaging in or watching recreational activities is unhealthy and detrimental to the health of others.
- 2. Tobacco products once consumed in public spaces are often discarded on the ground, thus posing a risk of ingestion to toddlers and wildlife and causing a litter problem.
- 3. As parents, leaders, coaches, and officials, we are thought of as role models, and the use of tobacco products around youth has a negative effect on their lifestyle choices.

#### **Tobacco-Free Facilities**

The City of Sioux Falls does not allow the use of tobacco products on City-owned playgrounds and facilities where youth activities (under 18 years old) take place. (Activities include softball, baseball, soccer, hockey, tennis, basketball, football; facilities include skateboard parks, pools, ice rinks, etc.)

## **Compliance Procedures**

The emphasis on enforcing the tobacco-free park policy is through voluntary compliance.

- 1. Signs will be posted at City-owned facilities.
- 2. Youth athletic associations that utilize City-owned facilities have committed to enforcing this policy during all scheduled events they sponsor.

#### **Definition of Terms**

**Youth Activities:** Activities in which the intended participants are those under 18 years of age.

**Tobacco products are defined as:** Chewing tobacco, cigarettes, cigarillos, cigars, electronic cigarettes, hookah, snuff, and snus.

**Use of tobacco products is defined as:** Any use of the above products on designated City-owned facilities where youth recreation activities are in commencement.

## Violation of the Policy

- 1. Any park patron at a City-owned park has the right to ask a tobacco user to extinguish or dispose of his or her tobacco product.
- 2. If person does not abide by the policy, a complaint form may be filled out by logging on to www.siouxfalls.org/parks.

3. Any person found violating this policy may be subject to immediate ejection from the recreation facility for the remainder of the event.

# Dissemination of the Policy

- 1. Participants, parents, and spectators will be notified of the policy through the sponsoring organization.
- 2. Parks and Recreation will include a tobacco-free ad in the Activities Guide year-round.
- 3. Signage will be provided in all tobacco-free areas.
- 4. Information will be posted on Parks and Recreation and on Health Department websites.
- 5. CityLink will air anti-tobacco public service announcements regularly.
