AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SIOUX FALLS, SD, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY BY INCREASING THE WATER RATES FOR CUSTOMERS TO SECTIONS 51.046, 51.047, 51.048, 51.049, 51.050, 51.052, 51.053, AND REPEALING SECTION 51.051 OF CHAPTER 51: WATER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SIOUX FALLS, SD:
