## 1. Purpose of Annual Progress Report

This report is the 2024 annual update to the Lincoln County and Minnehaha County Multi-Hazard Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan Update, herein referred to as the Hazard Mitigation Plan, adopted by the City of Sioux Falls on February 13, 2024. The Hazard Mitigation Plan is part of the City's participation requirements in FEMA's Community Rating System (CRS) Program. Because the City participates in the CRS Program as a Class 7 Community, Sioux Falls property owners receive a 15 percent discount on their flood insurance premiums. As part of CRS recertification, the City must provide an annual update on the implementation of floodplain management action items identified in the Hazard Mitigation Plan for Sioux Falls.

### 2. Overview

Minnehaha and Lincoln Counties and participating cities developed the Lincoln County and Minnehaha County Multi-Hazard Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan to reduce risk from all hazards by identifying resources, information, and strategies for risk reduction. The Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires state and local governments to develop hazard mitigation plans as a condition for federal disaster grant assistance. To prepare the plan, the participating partners organized resources, assessed risks from natural hazards within the county, developed planning goals and objectives, reviewed mitigation alternatives, and developed an action plan to address probable impacts from natural hazards. By completing this process, these jurisdictions maintained compliance with the Disaster Mitigation Act, achieving eligibility for mitigation grant funding opportunities afforded under the Robert T.
